



Certain medications in the drug classes below may require prior authorization. To obtain authorization, the provider must submit the appropriate Prior Authorization form to the WellCare Pharmacy department via fax at **1-877-277-6892**. The WellCare Pharmacy department will respond to all requests within 24 hours and, if authorized, will coordinate Delivery of the product.

*The drugs in the classes listed will require a prior authorization except for selected drugs in various classes that are listed on our “Ohio HCPCS No Authorization List”.
